January-August Comparison

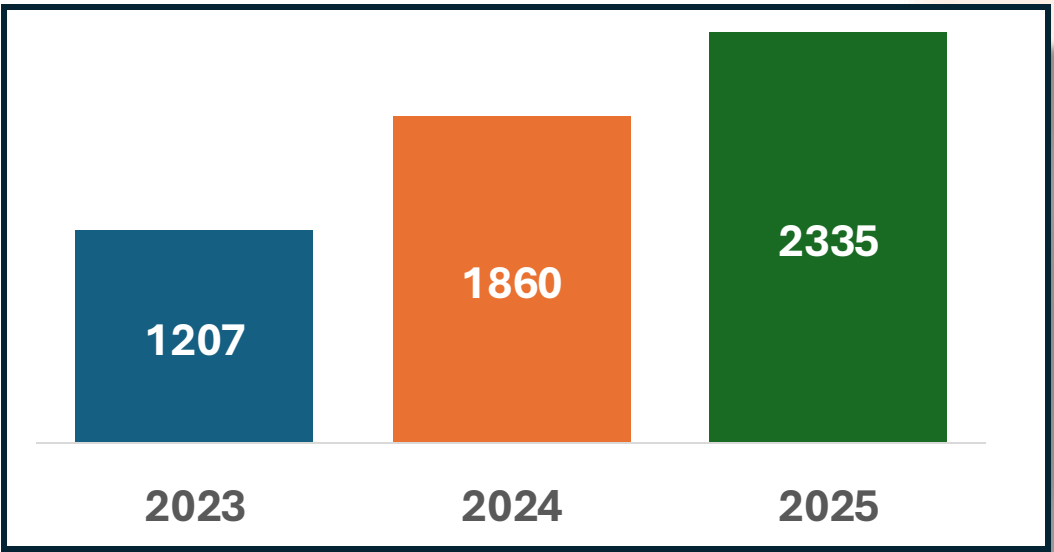
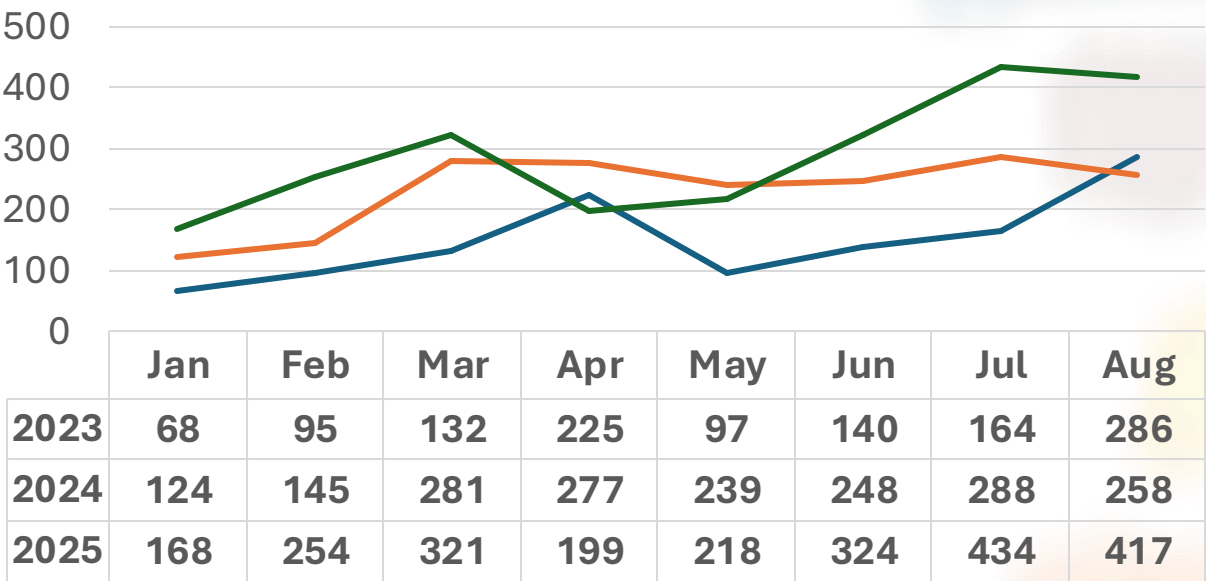
