

Residents/Property Owners

Year-round residents and/or owners of real estate in Wolfeboro are eligible to receive a library card at no charge. These cards are valid for two years from the date of issue and may be renewed at no charge. Proof of identity and proof of residency or property ownership must be presented in person or provided electronically.

Non-Resident Students of GWRSD/Brewster Academy Non-Resident Students & Teachers

No charge shall be made to students eligible to attend the K-12 schools in the Governor Wentworth Regional School district in the towns of Brookfield, Effingham, Middleton, New Durham, Ossipee, Tuftonboro, and Wolfeboro. Non-resident students and non-resident teachers at Brewster Academy are eligible to receive free library cards. All these cards shall expire on August 31 of the current school year. Graduating seniors' cards shall expire on June 30 of their graduation year.

GWRSD Employees

All employees of GWRSD K-12 schools located in the towns of Brookfield, Effingham, Middleton, New Durham, Ossipee, Tuftonboro, and Wolfeboro are eligible for non-resident GWRSD cards at no charge. These cards expire on August 31 of the current school year.

Town of Wolfeboro Employees

Non-resident employees of the Town of Wolfeboro are eligible for a library card at no charge. These cards expire one year from the date of issue.

All Others

All other non-residents may purchase a library card. The rates are: one year at \$75 per household, six months at \$50, or three months at \$40. Non-resident Veterans will receive a 50% discount on library cards upon request and presenting proof of service. Non-resident cards can be renewed upon payment of fee for the new period.
